- To update the member companies on the important periodical reports generated by the IAP online claims management system, graphical presentations of the reports (make wise, make & sub-make wise and city wise) highlighting the top-5 for the period January 2016 to March 2017 were shared with members.
- Summary of data of snatched/stolen vehicles fitted with tracking devices for the last five years (2012 to 2016) was circulated to member companies.
- The Committee reviewed and finalized the statistics of Health/Medical insurance business for the year 2016 and combined from 2014 to 2016 and posted on IAP website.
- The Committee reviewed and finalized the statistics of Crop & Livestock insurance business for the year 2016 and combined from 2014 to 2016 and posted on IAP website.
- Summary of Motor Insurance business extracted/compiled from members' annual reports

was reviewed and finalized by the Committee and posted on IAP website.

- Motor Transport Management Information System developed by Excise & Taxation Department is informative and helpful to provide easy access to the general public. The Committee suggested that the system may be made more efficient if all concerned departments are interlinked, so that important information such as change of ownership, tax payments etc. are automatically updated. In this regards IAP sent a representation to all Excise & Taxation offices.
- A meeting was held with DG/Director Licensing Division and Director Type Approval Directorate at PTA Headquarters, Islamabad in January 2017 which was attended by EC's representatives. Subsequent to this meeting the PTA arranged a

joint meeting with Vehicles Tracking Service Providers and IAP representatives in February, 2017. The PTA advised the tracking companies to provide the following documents:

- a. Interconnect agreements with Mobile Operators.
- b. Customer service agreement forms along with terms and conditions.
- c. Detail of type approved devices to be submitted to Director (Type Approval).
- d. Detail of Network Management System (NMS) up-gradation (if any).

The matter is being followed up consistently with PTA.
